




















## HOW TO MAKE THIS DOCUMENT A ZINE:

#### WHAT YOU NEED:

- A4 Piece of Paper
- Ruler
- Stanley Knife
- Colour A4 Printer
- Bone Folder (Optional)

#### Step #1:

Print out the document! This is best done with a DOUBLE SIDED-COLOUR function on your printer, with an A4 page.

#### Step #2:

Using a Stanley knife, ruler, and the crop marks in the corners of the page, cut the page down to size. Making sure that each side is even and straight.

#### Step #3:


Fold the page in half, open it up and fold it in half again. Continue these steps using the previous folds as a guide, to create a grid pattern that is 8 x 4 squares. (Like the reference grid on this page) Using the reference grid on this page, and the folds you just made. Cut along the centre of the page and on each side of that initial cut to create a curly t shape. (Make sure to use the folds as a guide for where to cut, ONLY CUT ON THE FOLDS)

#### Step #5:

Now that you have a crazy cut page, take the first square (marked as front cover in the guide) and fold the square in on itself to create an accordion fold. The pages should sit comfortably within each other back and forth, having each page and its number marked in the corresponding order.

#### Step #6:

Enjoy your new and adorable tiny zine! Can you figure out what the word is?
