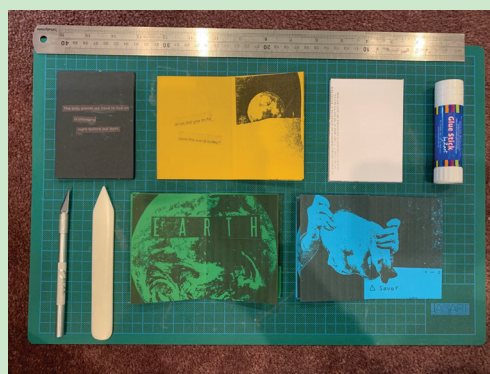

Simple Earth Zine

Instructions

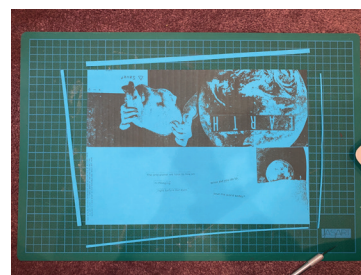
Materials:

- ✓ Paper (of any colour)
- ✓ Ruler
- ✓ Bone folder
- ✓ Blade / scissors
- ✓ Glue
- ✓ Positive attitude



STEP 1

Carefully Trim the edges of the paper to make sure the design reaches the end of the paper and is even.



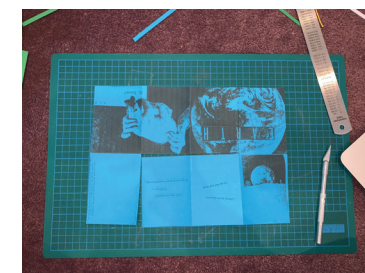
STEP 2

With your paper laying horizontally, fold in half lengthways, then in half width ways. Then fold the right and left sides of the page into the center fold. Your paper should have one fold running horizontally, and three running vertically.



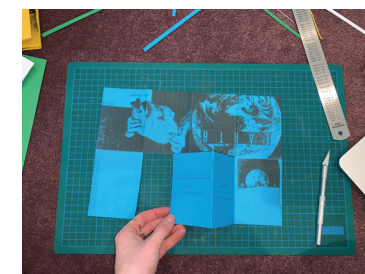
STEP 3

Cut an L shape, separating the center four cells in half horizontally, and separating the first and second bottom cells.



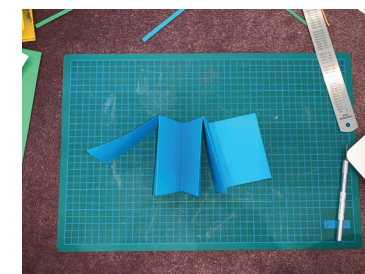
STEP 4

Begin folding your paper, making sure the first page is the one that reads "The only planet we have to live on is changing right before our eyes."



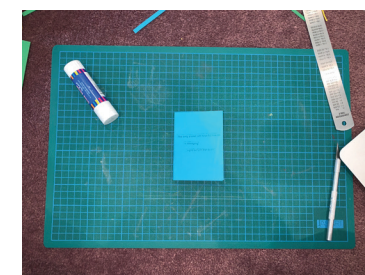
STEP 5

Once folded, glue the pages together on the unprinted sides. This ensures that the zine is sturdier and more compact. This step is also optional.



STEP 6

And now you are done! Make sure to enjoy your newly made zine, and take a moment to think about what you can do to make a positive impact on our planet.
