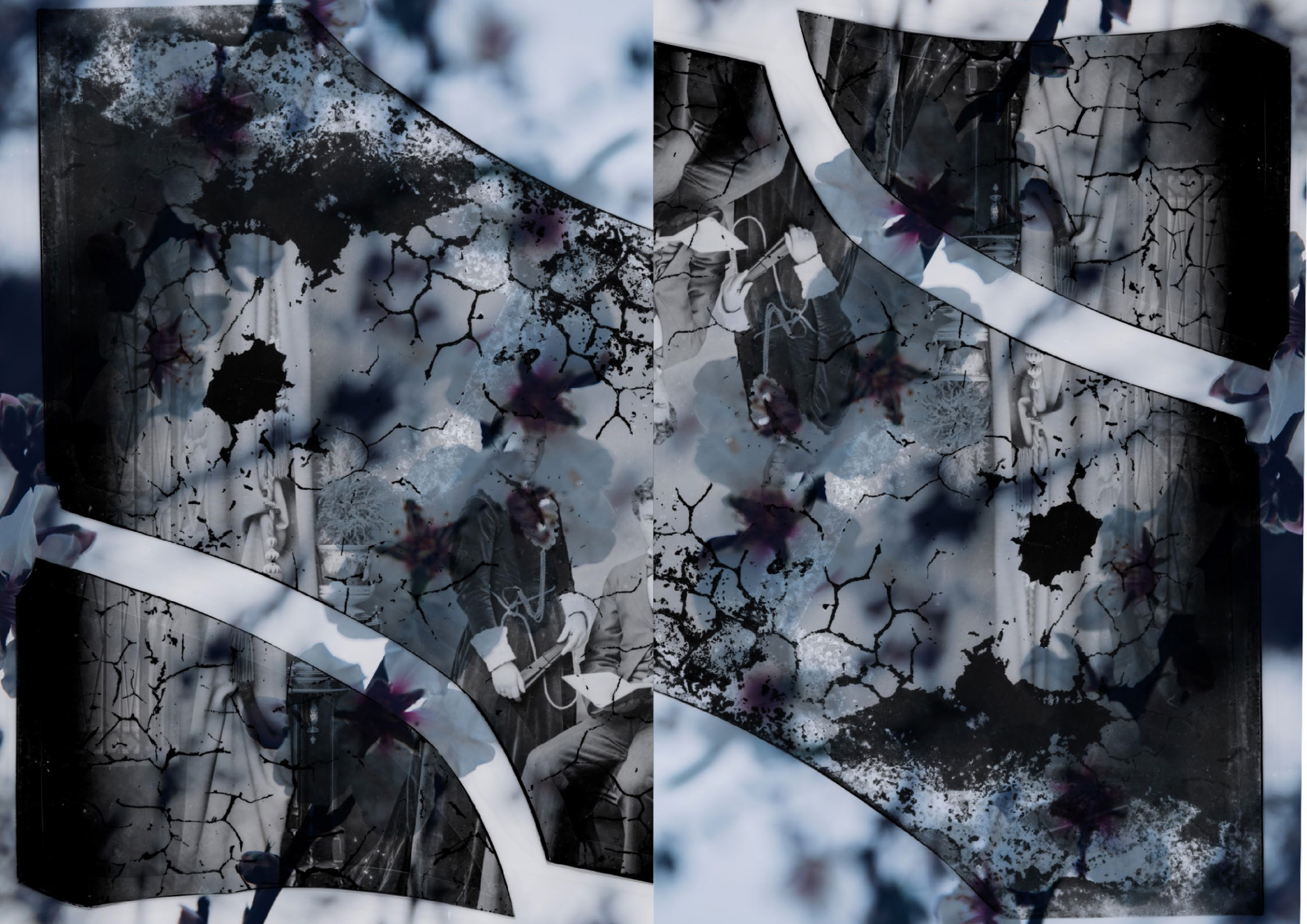




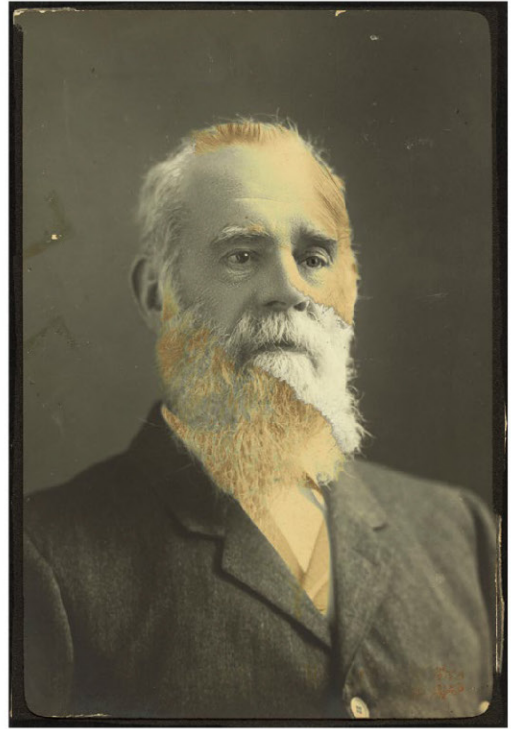

## Instructions

### Step 1.

Start off by printing the zine's spreads, using a printer you have at home. You can print the zine on whatever paper stock you have; noting it might be best to print on a thicker GSM. I would recommend 200 + GSM if you have it!

Print the zine on an A4 sized paper so the pages can fold into an A5 spread.

### Step 2.

Fold each page using your bone folder from left to right.



### Step 3.

The zine's design is based of traditional family photo albums & the punk zine scene. You can either keep the fold or stitch the zine using a pamphlet stitch of your choice. Only stitch the pages together not the cover)
