





## How to make a spiral concertina Zine




**1** Start with a piece of paper – this one is A4.








**3** The result is a set of rectangles defined by the fold lines.




**7** The Zine folds up to this size and shape.



6 The boxes are folded in a backwards and forwards pattern in concertina style according to the spiral produced by the cut lines.



**5** This coloured line shows where to cut the page to produce the spiral concertina Zine.



4 This is a good time to add artwork to the rectangles (boxes) on the page, or map out how the images might go.
